




Suggested Typical Installation Inward Opening Details SL 70 System





Higher Weather Performance Sill




Flush Sill
(Interior applications only)




Condition : Sill sits on top of the floor slab

The top of the finish floor is at the bottom of the sill flanges.



The floor slab is the finished floor.
Allow shim space as needed.

SHOWN, APPROPRIATE LANDING ON BOTH SIDES OF THE
THRESHOLD WITH ADA-COMPLIANT SLOPE MUST BE
CONSTRUCTED.



pattern and spacing by others


A - Ø3/8" (10)

A Drill holes all the way to the
back as shown at a slight angle
upwards.
Before creating the 3/8" (10mm)
drainage hole, we recommend
using a smaller drill bit to create a
pilot hole.
